Supplies:

- Stamp Sets Christmas to Remember (156300); Christmas Season (156293) *See note below to save 10%
- Card Stock Basic White (159276); Soft Succulent (155776); Early Espresso (119686);
- Stamp Pads Early Espresso (147114); Crumb Cake (147116); VersaMark Pad (102283)
- Misc. Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Seasonal Labels Dies* (156299); Timber 3D Embossing Folder (156406); Painted Christmas Designer Series Paper (156292); Heat Tool (129053); Basics Stampin' Emboss Powders (155554); Treasured Tags Pick a Punch (154425); Bone Folder (102300); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Seal (149699)

Measurements:

- Soft Succulent: 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼"
- Basic White: 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" (2 piece); 4" x 2-1/2"
- Painted Christmas Designer Series Paper: 4-1/4" x 3"
- Early Espresso: 5/8" wide strip

Instructions:

- 1. Fold the large piece of Soft Succulent cardstock in half. Burnish with bone folder and set aside.
- 2. Emboss one of the larger pieces of Basic White cardstock with the Timber 3D Embossing Folder. Adhere to the front of the card base with Stampin' Seal.
- 3. Adhere the piece of Painted Christmas Designer Series Paper to the embossed cardstock with Stampin' Seal.
- 4. Using Early Espresso Ink, stamp two of the smaller pinecone stamps onto the smaller piece of Basic White cardstock. Stamp one in the bottom right corner of the second piece of larger Basic White cardstock (this is for the inside of your card).
- 5. Using Crumb Cake ink, stamp the larger pinecone stamp overtop of the Early Espresso pinecones, taking care to line the images up.
- 6. Using Early Espresso Ink, stamp the "Love & Joy" sentiment onto the larger piece of cardstock, with the pinecone in the bottom corner. Adhere to the inside of the card with Stampin' Seal.
- 7. Use your Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine to die cut the two pinecones with the coordinating die in the Seasonal Labels Dies.
- 8. Adhere the left pinecone to the card with Stampin' Seal, and the right pinecone with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Stamp the "Merry Christmas" onto the Early Espresso strip with VersaMark ink. Pour white embossing powder overtop, and heat with the Heat Tool.
- 10. Punch the ends with the Treasured Tags Pick a Punch tool. *Note that the strip doesn't fit directly into one of the slots because it is larger than the 1/2" slot and narrower than the 3/4" slot. Take care to line it up for even punches on the end.
